POSITION: HEAVY DUTY DIESEL MECHANIC

Heavy Duty Diesel Mechanic equipment mechanics repair, troubleshoot, adjust, overhaul and maintain mobile heavy-duty construction equipment

Main responsibilities

- Inspects bulldozers, cranes, graders and other heavy construction equipment for proper performance, and inspect equipment to detect faults and malfunctions
- Diagnoses faults or malfunctions using computerized and other testing equipment to determine the extent of repair required
- Adjusts equipment and repair or replace defective parts, components or systems using hand and power tools
- Tests repaired equipment for proper performance and to ensure that work meets manufacturers' specifications
- Cleans, lubricates and performs other routine maintenance work on equipment
- Services attachments and working tools such as blades, ploughs, winches and side booms
- Perform repair work on heavy trucks, Excavators, Bulldozers

Requirements

The job holder must have a Technician Certificate in Mechanical Engineering Parts 1 & II from Government Technical Institute along with six (6) years' experience in the repair and maintenance of heavy diesel equipment, or equivalent; 3 years' experience of which must have specifically involved the repair of trucks or other heavy automotive equipment, or equivalent

Or

Certificate in Agriculture Machinery from Government Technical Institute along with ten (10) years in the repair and maintenance of heavy diesel equipment, or equivalent; 3 years' experience of which must have specifically involved the repair of trucks or other heavy automotive equipment, or equivalent

Supervisory Responsibility

This job holder will not be responsible for supervising any personnel.
