The incumbent is required to provide guidance on the design, development and maintenance of electrical control systems, equipment and machinery.

## **Main Responsibilities**

- Designs, maintains, implements, or improves electrical instruments, facilities, components, equipment products, or systems for industrial, commercial or domestic purposes.
- Performs a wide range of engineering tasks by operating computer-assisted design or engineering software and equipment.
- Ensures that installation and operations conform to standards by preparing electrical systems specifications and technical drawings.
- Establishes construction, manufacturing, or installation standards or specifications by performing a wide range of detailed calculations.
- Ensures compliance with specifications, codes, or customer requirements by directing or coordinating installation, manufacturing, construction, maintenance, documentation, support or testing activities.
- Writes reports and compile data regarding existing and potential electrical engineering projects and studies.
- Prepares specifications for purchases of electrical equipment and materials.
- Supervises or trains project team members.

Supervises the construction and maintenance of NDIA's Structures, with regards to

electrical systems which includes offices pump, stations and generators

Estimates material, labour and construction costs for budget preparation.

Maintains electrical equipment.
