The incumbent will be required to assist in the transportation of Excavators, Fuel and other hydraulic equipment to various location.

Key duties and Responsibilities:

- operates low bed machine and equipment (eg. Hauler, trailer)
- Keeps a log book by recording quantities of fuel and oil used and particulars of all journeys undertaken.
- Does minor repairs/maintenance to equipment.
- Ensure proper storage of fuel and lubricants.
- Performs other related duties set by the Engineer from time to time;

Requirements:

The job holder must have a valid driver's license to operate Hauler Truck along with five (5) years' experience operating same.

Supervisory Responsibility

This job holder will not be responsible for supervising any personnel.

Work Environment

While performing the duties of this job, the employee regularly works in the field setting.

Physical Demands
